The person who guesses the most categories correctly has a chance to win 4 cinema tickets!

To enter, just pick up a ballot form – available at Richard Booth's Bookshop, Café or Cinema – and make your selections from the nominations listed. Regular customers will know the films well, as most have been screened in the cinema over the past 12 months. The 9 categories in the competition are: Best Picture; Lead Actor; Lead Actress; Supporting Actor; Supporting Actress; Best Original Score; Best Original Screenplay; Achievement in Directing; Cinematography. The awards ceremony is televised live from Hollywood on Monday 27th February (UK time). Results of the competition will be announced on Wednesday 29th February. The prize will go to the person who guesses the most Oscar winners correctly. In the event of a draw, the 4 tickets will be split equally. Drop your completed ballot form into one of the jars located in the Bookshop, Café or Cinema.

Deadline for Entries: Saturday 25th February, 12 noon.

Terms and Conditions

2. Employees of Richard Booth's Bookshop, Café or Cinema, or their family members or anyone else connected in any way with the competition or helping to set up the competition shall not be permitted to enter the competition.
3. There is no entry fee and no purchase necessary to enter this competition.
4. Entrance is in person only, by the completion of the designated ballot form. Ballots are available from Richard Booth's Bookshop, Café and Cinema.
5. Only one entry per person.
6. Entries are accepted from January 28th. The closing date is Saturday 25th February at 12 noon. After this date no further entries to the competition will be permitted.
7. No responsibility can be accepted for entries not received.
8. Richard Booth's Bookshop reserves the right to cancel or amend the competition and these terms and conditions without notice in the event of a catastrophe, war, civil or military disturbance, act of God or any actual or anticipated breach of any applicable law or regulation or any other event outside of the promoter's control. Entrants will be notified of any changes to the competition as soon as possible.
9. The promoter is not responsible for inaccurate prize details supplied to any entrant by any third party connected with this competition.

10. No cash alternative to the prizes will be offered. The prizes are not transferable. Prizes are subject to availability and we reserve the right to substitute any prize with another of equivalent value without giving notice.
11. The prize for this competition is 4 cinema tickets. These tickets will be issued as vouchers, which will be subject to our usual terms and conditions.
12. The winner will be the person who successfully predicts the highest number of award winners for the 9 categories in the competition, as recorded on their ballot. These nine categories are: Best Motion Picture of the Year; Performance by an Actor in a Leading Role; Performance by an Actor in a Supporting Role; Performance by an Actress in a Leading Role; Performance by an Actress in a Supporting Role; Achievement in Directing; Original Screenplay; Achievement in Cinematography; Achievement in Music Written for Motion Pictures (Original Score).

In the event of multiple winners (i.e. the highest number of categories guessed correctly is achieved by two or more entrants), the 4 tickets will be shared equally between them to the nearest whole number. If more than 4 people draw, these ballots will be put into a hat and 4 winners will be drawn at random.
14. Results of the competition will be announced on Wednesday 29th February. The winner/s will be notified by phone within 28 days of the closing date. If the winner/s cannot be contacted or do not claim the prize within 14 days of notification, we reserve the right to withdraw the prize from the winner and pick a replacement winner.
