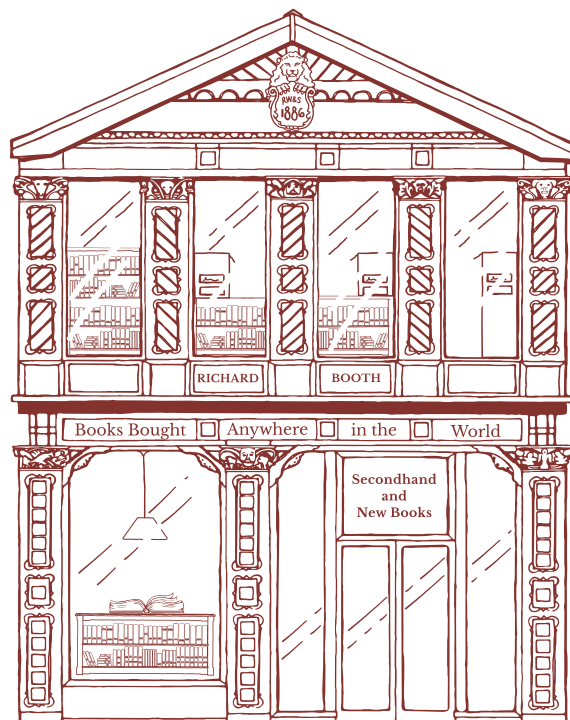




RICHARD BOOTH'S BOOKSHOP

This landmark bookshop on Lion Street extends over three floors, is packed with volumes from near and far and managed by specialist department heads.

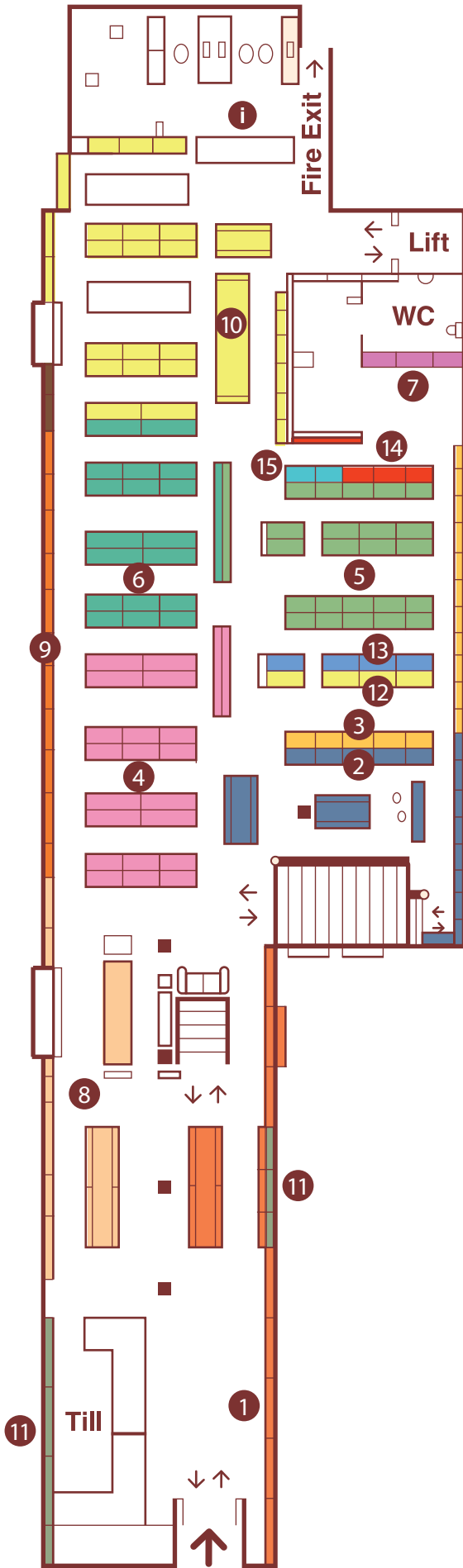

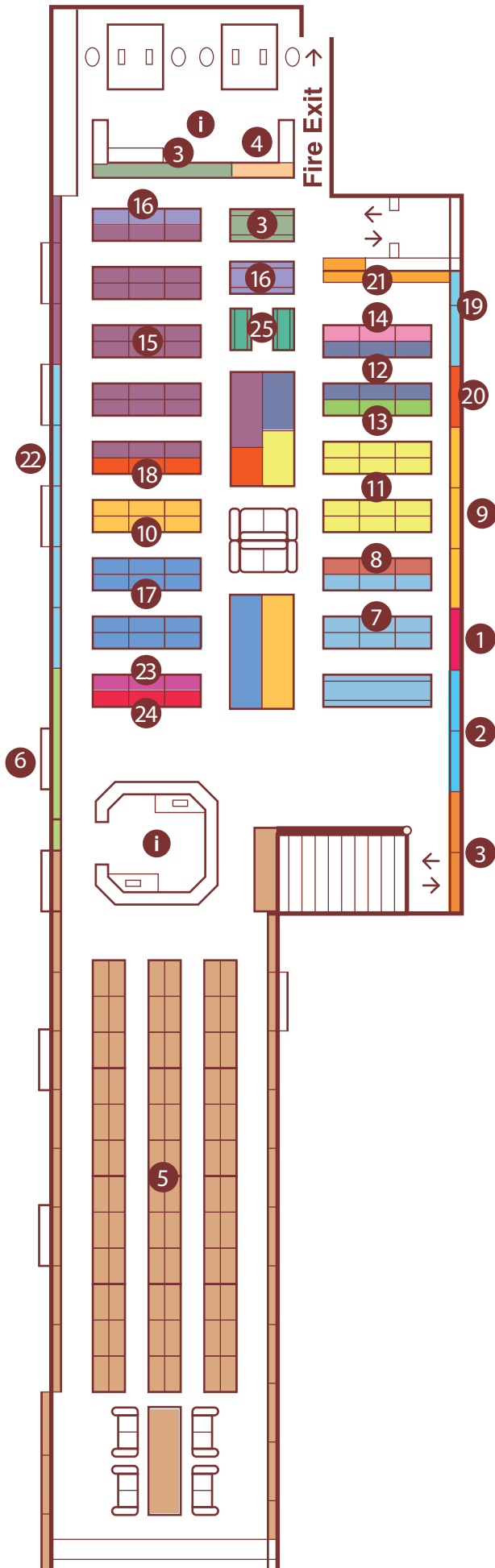

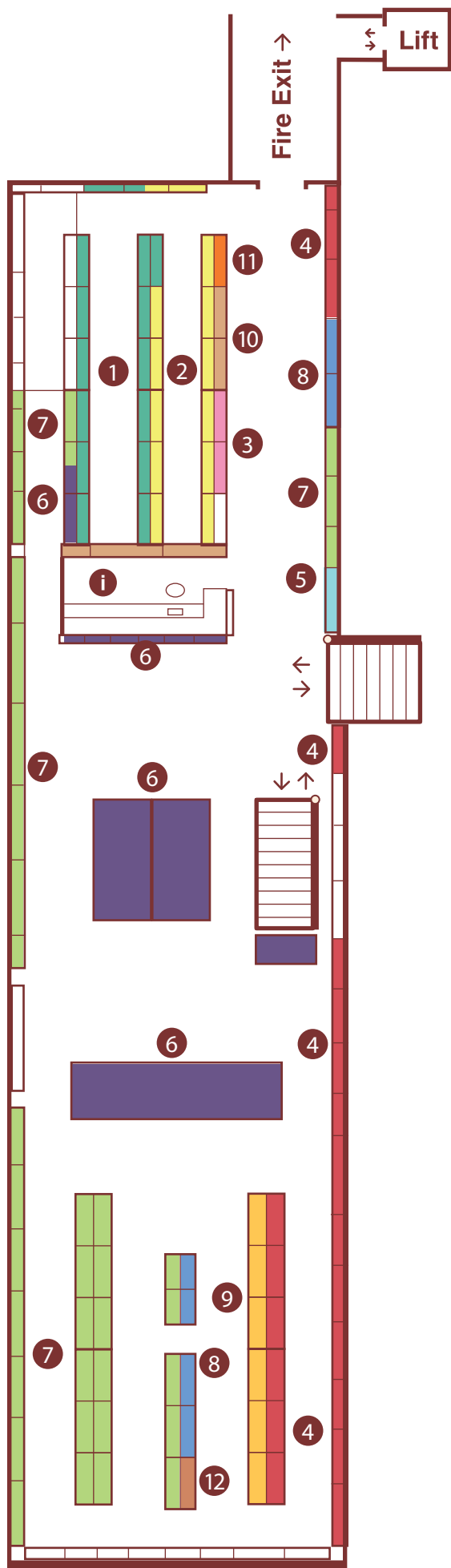
